DOWNTOWN FREE ZONE SHUTTLE SERVICE

6:15 am - 9:15 pm daily.

The Fort Worth T offers free step on transportation throughout the downtown area. The Free Zone is bounded by Henderson, Jones, Belknap and Lancaster Streets. Buses run approximately 15-30 minutes apart from.

ROUTE 1 - HISTORIC STOCKYARDS - NORTHBOUND (CITY BUS) \$1.50 FARE EACH WAY

Transportation from ITC and downtown to the Stockyards Historical District. Runs every 15 minutes Mon-Sat. every hour on Sunday.

ROUTE 2 - CAMP BOWIE/MUSEUMS (CITY BUS) \$1.50 FARE EACH WAY

Transportation from ITC and Sundance Square to the museums on Camp Bowie and Ridgmar Mall. Runs every 15 minutes M-F, every 30 minutes on Sat., and every hour on Sun.

ROUTE 7 - CULTURAL DISTRICT/ZOO (CITY BUS) \$1.50 FARE EACH WAY

Transportation from ITC and downtown to the Cultural District, museums, and zoo. Runs every 30 minutes Mon-Sat., and every hour on Sunday.

ROUTE 18 - FORT WORTH ZOO SAFARI SHUTTLE (GREEN TROLLEY) SATURDAY SERVICE ONLY • \$1.50 FARE EACH WAY

Transportation from ITC, Fort Worth Zoo, and Will Rogers Center Visitor Center. Runs every 30 minutes.
